Concert Attire

Each student is expected to supply their own concert attire. The same attire can be worn at each concert. I encourage you to begin gathering concert attire soon. Please read the following guidelines:

- All attire should be black in color and dressy in style, without additional other colors or colored trims.
- All black pants should be full length (no shorts). All dresses and skirts should fall between the knee and ankle. Black nylons or tights should be worn if the dress or skirt does not fall near the ankle.
- All tops should be limited to a black dress shirt, blouse or top. Please avoid strapless or exposing styles.
- All socks and hosiery should be black. Shoes should be black dress shoes. Please be cautious of using the risers and stage movement in tall heels.
